I am to forward herewith the proposal received in the reference cited and to inform you that this Government has "No Objection" for the affiliation of CBSE, New Delhi, to be granted for the Classes I to VIII (E/M) during the Academic Year, 2020-21, to 'Sloka School', Manneguda, Abdullapurmet(M), Ranga Reddy District, subject to the following conditions:-

- The Educational agency shall submit the Annual Administration Report in the prescribed proforma as prescribed in G.O.Ms.No.1 Education, dated:01.01.1994, to the competent authority for every financial year by 30th of September at the latest. Such Report shall be supported by the audited statement of accounts of the school duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- The School Management shall upload their school information in the web site of the State School Education department including their fees details and other required information useful to the parents.
- The Management should follow the provisions of the Telangana Education Act, 1982; G.O.Ms.No.1, Education (PS.2) Department, dt.01.01.1994, as amended from time to time and Compulsory Teaching and Learning of Telugu as per the provisions of the Act No.10 of 2018, dt.30.03.2018, which came into force from 02.04.2018 and the connected Rules to this Act issued vide G.O.Ms.No.15, School Education (Prog.II) Department, dt:01.06.2018. The Government have also prescribed the books to be introduced for Classes I and VI which have to be followed for the Compulsory Teaching & Learning of Telugu language as per this Act 10 of 2018 & the connected Rules.
